All participants must be financial members of their State Association and an affiliated club.

MUSIC:

1. Competitors are requested to email their music track to olympicfigureskatingclub@gmail.com by 13th November

Please name the music file as follows: Division Name – Skater Name eg Preliminary – Sue Smith

2. Skaters may also hand in their music on **CD**. The CD must be presented in a plastic case or sleeve, contain only ONE track, and must be marked with:

- Competitor's Name, Event eg "Primary Ladies" & Program Identification, eg "Short Program"
- Running time of music (NOT skating time)

Please Note: All competitors should also have a second copy of their music available if required.

Music will be added to a computer playlist for playing at the event. All tracks will be deleted on completion of the event and all music remains the property of the skater.

JUDGES:

Provided by Ice Skating Victoria

MARKING:

Closed marking will be used for all events. IJS system will be used for Preliminary to Senior events, and Aussie Skate. Artistic will be judged using IJS program components.

ARTISTIC:

Props will be allowed in this competition as long as they are safe. Please check prior to the event if unsure.

MEDALS:

First, Second, and Third places will receive medals, Encouragement Skaters will receive an attendance medal.

PRESENTATIONS:

Presentations will be on ice after the event.
